From West or South take I-64 East to Route 33 through West Point, Glenns and Saluda to Deltaville, right at Little Sue/Exxon

From Hampton Roads take I-64 to US 17 to Gloucester, turn right on Rt. 3 to Hartfield then right on Rt. 33 to Deltaville, Right at Little Sue......

From Little Sue/Exxon: Follow Fishing Bay Road road to water, bear left. Follow Stove Point Road to Yacht Club. Abide by speed limit on Stove Point Road (private road)


