

# NOTICE OF RACE

## 50<sup>TH</sup> MOBJACK NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP REGATTA



The International Mobjack Association and the Ware River Yacht Club invite entries to the 2009 Mobjack National Championship Regatta August 21, 22 and 23, 2009 to be sailed on the Ware River at the headwaters of the Mobjack Bay, Gloucester, VA, USA

The Regatta will be a three day series with two or more races scheduled each day and will determine the 2009 International Mobjack Class Champion. A minimum of three races will be required to constitute a Championship. Saturday will include a reunion long distance race which will include entries for that day only, followed by a reunion dinner party.

The 2008-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing from the International Sailing Federation, as modified by the United States Sailing Association, the Mobjack Class Racing Rules and the Regatta Sailing Instructions will apply.

The Regatta is restricted to boats of the Mobjack Class. A Mobjack is eligible to race and is considered in the Mobjack Class only if it is registered to and is owned by or chartered by an active or isolated member in good standing, or by a syndicate or club. The boat must conform in all respects to the Mobjack Class Specifications.

Skippers must be active or isolated members in good standing. Dues can be paid with the registration. In the interest of promoting the Mobjack Class, a member in good standing may designate an associate member or an individual from outside the class to skipper his boat. Other restrictions apply; see the International Mobjack Association Constitution and By-Laws for additional details. Saturday's long distance race will be open to those sailors with a connection to the class over it's 50 year history.

Competitors are required to complete a registration form before the skippers meeting August 7, 2009. Paid registrations received before August 1, 2009 are eligible for a discount. Additional information will follow on the Mobjack and CBYRA Web sites. Official Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.
