

## Directions and Accommodations

### How to get there:

Follow US Route 17 from North or South to the Village of Gloucester ("Gloucester Courthouse"). Take Business Rt. 17 (Main Street) into the middle of town. Turn east on Rt. 3 & 14 at traffic light. Go about 2 miles, turn right on Rt. 623 (Ware Neck Rd.). Follow WRYC burgee signs to Ware Point Road, look for club entrance on right. For those trailering boats, park in the large grassy field until ready to launch. The overhead power line is high enough to clear a Mobjack with rigged mast. Restrooms with showers are in building on right. The Club House is ahead on right.

### Accommodations

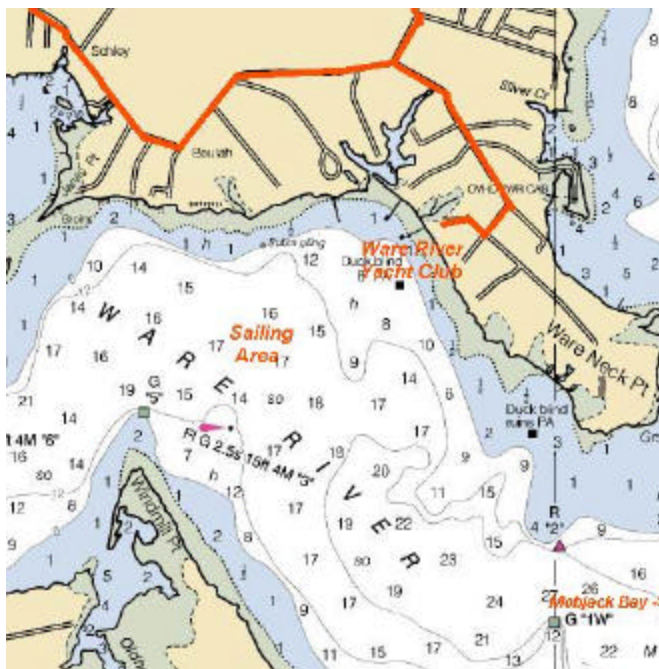
